Similar walks have been held previously in Prayagraj, Bhubaneswar, Shillong, Nashik, and Hyderabad.

The walk, themed "Zamorin's Trail: Exploring Kozhikode's Glorious Heritage," offered participants a unique opportunity to delve into the city's vibrant past. It commenced in the morning from the Tali Shiva Temple and concluded at the 1980's restaurant, passing through significant heritage landmarks, including Palayam, SM Street (Mittai Theruvu), Kuttichira's historic mosques, Gujarati Street, the Big Bazaar Market, and more. The journey truly highlighted the city's rich legacy of cosmopolitanism, religious harmony, governance, literature, and scholarship. Led by Sruthin Lal, a culture and heritage practitioner, the walk was attended by members of the local community, government officials, media, and senior leadership of IndiGo and InterGlobe Foundation.
